The Advent Wreath has four purple candles and one of white. The first candle is lit on Advent Sunday; additional ones are lit, one on each Sunday, and the white on Christmas Day. Traditions vary from church to church, but usually the third week in Advent is set aside as more celebratory than others.

The tradition that each candle of the Advent wreath has a meaning is likewise not official. The rose candle has always been connected with joy, because the third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday (gaudete means rejoice in Latin). As for the other candles, their meanings are somewhat up for grabs.
