Guided reading is all about practice, so have students whisper read (or silently read – in late first grade and second grade) all of the words on their own. That said, some students in Kindergarten or early first grade may need more support than the book introduction in order to be successful with the text.

What are the components of a guided reading lesson in a ...

When your readers get to guided reading levels K-M in second grade, they are silently reading most of the time. We only want them to read aloud softly so that we can check in on them – think of it as a mini-conference. This means that monitoring comprehension is even more important than ever. We use these conversations to double-check and know if they are understanding what they are reading.
