In the conclusion of his essay, Derrida observes that there are two ways to interpret structure, sign, and play. One seeks to decipher a truth or an origin, and avoids play. The other affirms play and tries to pass beyond man and humanism. The first way was dominant throughout human history. The second way is only emerging now.

Coining the term 'sous rature' to express "the inadequacy of the sign", Jacques Derrida brings forth the notion that every sign is written under erasure. Aiming to liberate language from the age-old concept, he said that there are two interpretations of 'interpretation', 'structure', 'sign' and 'free play':
